

## Bethesda Post Abortion Healing Ministry Services and Budget

Bethesda Healing Ministry is funded for the most part on fundraising efforts through an annual fundraising event, grants and private contributions. Bethesda has a number of different expenses with the heart of the ministry focused to serve those (women, men and families) wounded by abortion.

Our annual expenses are projected to be:

Retreats and training for our current and new volunteer Ministry Leadership Team. We need to provide spiritual support and ongoing training for those ministering to our members. We also want to provide more education of **priests and seminarians** through retreats and seminar training on post abortion healing.

Expansion of our services to current affiliates and to increase the number of affiliates modeling our approach through seminars and resources.



Extension of our outreach through events, social media, and website development to reach all in need of healing, especially men and women ages 18-24 years.
